SECTION A - GENERAL RULES

1. Horses and ponies, shown in-hand or ridden, must be 15 years old and over and in a sound, healthy condition.
2. VH Showing will not accept liability for any accident, injury, loss, damage or illness to spectators, riders, handlers, horses, ponies or their property however caused. VH Showing always promotes a Health & Safety policy.
3. **MEMBERSHIP AND HORSE PASSPORT OVER-STAMP** (contact VHS – Welsh Office)
All riders/handlers must be members of Veteran Horse Society. All new horses/ponies must have passports over-stamped by Veteran Horse Society.
4. **SHOW CARDS** (contact VH Showing – Staffordshire Office)
Members wishing to compete and qualify for Olympia must ensure their horse/pony is registered with VH Showing Office. Showing cards will be issued and signed by the secretary and shall remain the property and copyright of Showing. If you have lost your card please contact the Showing Office and a replacement can be sent for an administration charge of £5.
5. **OWNER-ONLY REGISTRATION** (contact VH Showing – Staffordshire Office)
If the owner is not competing with the animal the owner is required to register with the Showing Office. The owner is the name on the equine passport. No owner can be under the age of 16 yrs.
6. **PARENT/GAURDIAN REGISTRATION** (contact VH Showing – Staffordshire Office)
Rider/handlers under the age of 16 will require a Parent/Guardian registration.
7. All registrations will run from 1st January to 31st December. All competitors/members are to abide by VH Showing rules.
8. To compete in a Regional Final you must be a fully paid member of VHS with a membership/registration show card (or a covering letter from the show office) and your mount must be registered with VH Showing. Once qualified, you must compete in the Regional Final **on the same registered horse/pony, rider/handler combination.**
9. Competitors wishing to see their marks from Regional Finals must send a SAE to the Show Office stating which Show, Entry Number, Class and name of rider/handler.
10. In the event of any change of ownership the Showing Office must be informed in writing and the necessary documentation will be issued.
11. All Registrations/Memberships/Entries/Stabling are **non-refundable**.
12. Any member found to have brought VH Showing into disrepute through cruelty or dishonesty will have their membership/registrations/affiliations revoked immediately.
13. Equine passports must always be carried at shows and produced on request.
14. In order to compete at the Olympia Grand Final all horses/ponies must meet current FEI vaccination regulations and dope testing procedures.
15. Please be aware that dope testing may take place at any show affiliated to VHS. The shows' policies and rules will take precedence over VHS rules.
16. A show society rules will take precedence over VHS rules regarding riding hats.
17. **VH Showing trophies.** A £15 refundable deposit must be paid by competitors who have been awarded a trophy. All trophies must be returned by the date stated on the trophy contract before the same competition the following year and must be in a clean undamaged condition, as detailed in the terms & conditions of acceptance of the trophy.
18. **HOME PRODUCED** No horse/pony may have been in a **Professional Horse/Pony Showing Yard** since the 1st January in the current year. Horse/ponies must be shown by an exhibitor who has not been involved with professionally producing animals for the show ring since 1st January in the current year. Owners, exhibitors and handlers must not have produced any horse/pony, other than their own, for financial gain since 1st January in the current year.
19. **Definition of a Professional Showing Producer/Rider/Handler:** A person who produces or rides or handles horses/ponies for financial gain, including preparation, schooling for the show ring, including at a show for another exhibitor.
20. Riders/handlers cannot exhibit under any judge if they have kept horses/ponies at livery/stud or has leased, loaned, or produced by the judge since 1st January the previous year.

SECTION B - DISCIPLINARY

Complaints procedure

Members wishing to register an objection or complaint must follow the complaints procedure in full before the matter will be investigated. **Two** separate letters must be received from unrelated members from different families. Full details of the event/complaint must be set out in writing and received by VH Showing within 14 days after the event in question. The letters must be sent by recorded delivery together with a payment of £25 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld by the VH Showing Complaints Committee. **Communications by telephone or e-mail will be disregarded.** No complaint will be considered unless this procedure has been followed.

SECTION C - SHOWING GUIDELINES

Age groups for showing classes:

| Lead Rein Classes | 3-7 years. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday by 1st January in the current year and must be accompanied by an adult. Lead rein handlers must be VH Showing members. At Regional/Grand Finals, lead reins ponies will be asked to strip. The pony must be led up by the handler and not the child rider. |
| Juniors | 8-16 years. Age as at 1st January in current year.
Please Note: All junior competitors in the ridden section must be competent in: Walk – Trot – Canter – Change of Direction and be capable of going round in a group. |
| Other in-hand classes | Minimum age 9 years. Handlers must be competent enough to handle their veteran without assistance. |
| Stallions | Riders and handlers must be a minimum age of 16. |
| All Riders | To be a suitable size and weight for the horse/pony. |
- Excessive use of whips/showing canes or misuse of any equipment will result in exclusion from the show ring and possible further disciplinary action may be taken.
 - Showings Canes/whips exceeding 76cm (30") will not be permitted.
 - Spurs/spur bands are not permitted in any VH Showing classes.**
 - Late entries are not allowed in the ring once the order to trot has been given. No competitor will be judged if they have not completed the initial go around. Competitors cannot leave or return to the show ring without the judge's or steward's permission.
 - Any fall of a horse/rider will result in disqualification and the rider will not be allowed to re-mount.
 - Foals will not be permitted in the ring.
 - At Regional Finals the age of the horse/pony must be clearly displayed on the offside of the bridle. Approved VH Showing badges (black lettering on a white background) to be worn, these are readily available from the Showing Office. The first Age Badge is issued 'Free of Charge'. Additional Badges are £5 including Postage & Packaging.
 - Marking system:

Out of 50	-	Way of going, Manners and Movement
Out of 50	-	Presentation, Condition, Type and suppleness for age
 - In the event of a tie the "Way of going" mark will take precedence. Any marks noted incorrectly/inadvertently by the steward may be adjusted and must be signed/initialled by the judge. No half marks will be allowed.
 - The judge's decision is final.
 - Confrontation with a judge in or around the ring is strictly forbidden and will lead to disciplinary action.**
 - Mobile phones are not allowed in the show ring.

SECTION D – SHOWING GUIDELINES (HORSES/PONIES)

1. Horses/ponies that have suffered injuries in the past resulting in scarring or blemishes will not be penalised within the marking system, providing the horse/pony has completely recovered and is showing no signs of discomfort.
2. Excessive use of make-up will be penalised.
3. The judge will not ride your horse/pony in the ridden classes.
4. No horse/pony is expected to gallop in any veteran class. **Any galloping will be severely penalised.**
5. First Ridden competitors will be expected to be able to canter on the initial 'go round' as well as the individual show.
6. Within the marking system, only walk, trot and canter will be marked during the classes. All other paces, (counter-canter, rein-back, flying changes) will not be marked.

SECTION E – DRESS (RIDERS/HANDLERS) TACK (HORSES/PONIES)

IN HAND—HANDLERS/GROOMS

Handlers

1. Must be suitably attired.
2. Body jewellery and facial piercings are not permitted.
3. Handlers of horse/pony at an unaffiliated/affiliated show must wear a suitable hat or cap.
4. It is **mandatory** for competitors up to and including the age of 16 to wear correctly secured riding hats to the current approved BSI or European standard.

Grooms

To wear hat, smart jacket, trousers (cords, jodhpurs, slacks). **Shorts are not allowed.**

Failure to adhere to this rule will result in the groom being asked to leave the ring.

RIDDEN—RIDER

1. Jacket—plain colour or tweed.
2. Jodhpurs—beige or canary yellow.
3. Shirt with tie or stock. Gloves to be worn. Footwear—jodhpur boots (juniors), long riding boots (seniors).
4. Body jewellery and facial piercings are not permitted.
5. Anyone riding a horse/pony at any show must wear a hard hat. In all VH Showing classes it is strongly recommended that competitors over the age of 16 wear skull caps or riding hats in accordance with the current approved BSI or European standard. It is **mandatory** for competitors up to and including the age of 16 to wear correctly secured riding hats to the current approved BSI or European standard in all VH Showing classes and championships.
6. **Spurs/spur bands are not permitted in any VH Showing classes.**

HORSES/PONIES

1. Tack must be in good condition and correctly fitted.
2. **NOTE:** Lead rein exhibits must be shown in a snaffle bridle. The lead rein must be attached to the noseband at all times during the class. Riders of lead reins are not permitted to carry whips.
3. Stallions must be bitted - stallion harness is **NOT** permitted.
4. No item of tack can be removed or exchanged whilst a class is in progress without the judges' permission.
5. No boots are allowed.
6. BITS - Double, Pelham, Snaffle bits are accepted. **Gags and Bubble bits are NOT accepted.**

SECTION F - SHOWING CLASSES FOR 2012

As the veteran horses/ponies cover such a wide range of breeds, types and sizes, it has been necessary to split the ages into In-Hand and Ridden sections. We hope that by splitting the showing classes into 6 categories, we will produce a level so that competitors will not be disadvantaged. By keeping the limit to 6 classes, we feel this will be more acceptable for showing secretaries to deal with. Also giving members the opportunity to compete in a class more suited to their veteran.

Please find listed below the classes we are asking each show to run:

Class 1	-	IN HAND	Pre-Veteran	(15-19 years old)
Class 2	-	IN HAND	Veteran	(20-24 years old)
Class 3	-	IN HAND	Veteran Plus	(25 years old and over)
Class 4	-	RIDDEN	Pre-Veteran	(15-19 years old)
Class 5	-	RIDDEN	Veteran	(20-24 years old)
Class 6	-	RIDDEN	Veteran Plus	(25 years old and over)

or

Class 1	-	IN HAND*	Open mixed age exceeding 15 years old
Class 2	-	RIDDEN*	Open mixed age exceeding 15 years old

* In open age classes qualification cards/rosettes/vouchers must still be given out to each age group i.e. Pre-Veteran, Veteran and Veteran Plus, regardless of their position within the class.

SECTION G—Qualifiers—Area/Regional/Grand Final

AREA QUALIFIERS

These shows are held throughout the UK. Members and non-members may compete in the VH Showing series. The three highest placed VH Showing members in each class will then be eligible to compete in the Regional Finals, providing they are paid up members of the society and their horse/pony is registered with VH Showing. Qualification will be awarded down the line to the highest placed VH Showing member regardless of their position within the class. Once qualified at an Area Show, competitors must send their qualification card (with A5 SAE) to the address stated on the card. When the Regional Acceptance Card has been returned, the member can then compete in any Regional Final.

All show dates are updated on our website: www.veteran-horse-showing.co.uk. If you cannot visit our website, please send A5 SAE to the VH Showing Office.

REGIONAL FINALS

To compete in a Regional Final you must be a fully paid member of VHS with a membership and registration show card (or a covering letter from the show office) and your mount must be registered with VH Showing. Once qualified, you must compete in the Regional Final **on the same registered horse/pony, rider/handler combination.**

Regional Finals are open to the three highest VH Showing members from each of the Area Qualifiers. All Area winners will be notified of the Regional Finals. A list of Regional Finals will be on the VH Showing website. Each VH Showing member must produce their membership card, VH Showing registration card and the Regional Acceptance Card before entering the ring. If, for whatever reason, a competitor is unable to compete in the Grand Final, the qualification will be handed down to the next eligible competitor.

Competitors may be asked to perform a set show.

GRAND FINAL

The champions from each Regional Final will go forward to the Grand Final, which is held at the Olympia International Horse Show, to find the Supreme Veteran Champion for 2012.

SECTION H - PERFORMANCE AWARDS

The purpose of the Performance Awards Scheme is to encourage and reward the capabilities of the veteran horse and pony by offering a wide range of classes and activities in the equestrian world.

The competition is open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings age 15 years and over.

Owners/Riders/Handlers must be fully paid members of the Veteran Horse Society - Horses/Ponies must be registered with the VH Showing each year to be eligible for the Performance Awards scheme.

The competition runs from the 1st January to the 31st December. Those applying after the start date can only gain points after the entry fee has been received by the Showing Office so please apply as early as possible.

Entry fee is £10.00 per horse/pony and entry forms can be obtained from the Showing Office or online at www.veteran-horse-showing.co.uk. Extra results cards can be obtained free of charge by sending A5 SAE to the Showing Office.

All entrants must register in one of the following groups:

Pre-Veteran (15 – 19years)

Group 1 – Ponies not exceeding 148cms

Group 2 – Horses exceeding 148cms

Veteran Plus (25 years and over)

Group 5 – Ponies not exceeding 148cms

Group 6– Horses exceeding 148cms

Veteran (20 – 24 years)

Group 3– Ponies not exceeding 148cms

Group 4 – Horses exceeding 148cms

Veteran In-Hand only

Group 7– Ponies not exceeding 148cms

Group 8– Horses exceeding 148cms

Results cards must be signed by the Judge/Secretary to gain points. Competitors should complete and total their own scores. Completed results cards must be returned to the Showing Office postmarked no later than 7th January. No late entries will be accepted.

Please keep a photocopy of your results card before posting. Recorded delivery is the recommended method of posting as the VH Showing cannot be held responsible for lost post.

Please send an SAE if you require an acknowledgement of receipt of your card(s). Scores will be checked and any discrepancies will be raised with the competitor.

Results will be issued by 1st February. The organiser's decision is final and binding at all times.

Prizes will be awarded dependant on entries. A trophy will be awarded to the winner from each group and placings from 1–6 will be awarded with rosettes and prize cards sent out by post. All competitors gaining 600 points or more will receive a rosette by post. Veterans over 30 years old may only count their first 12 competitions.

Please keep photo copies of your result card before posting, to insure against loss in the post. Please send SAE if you require an acknowledgement of receipt of cards.

NOTE: Riders/Handlers must be fully paid members of the Veteran Horse Society. Horses/Ponies must be registered with the VH Showing/Dressage each year to be eligible for the Performance Awards scheme. To compete in the Performance Awards, competitors must be the same rider/handler/animal combination.

SECTION I—JUDGES GUIDELINES

1. All judges must be members of VH Showing and are covered by insurance whilst judging and Health & Safety forms have been completed (Section A - item 4).
2. Before any VH Showing classes may commence, all judges must complete their safety checklist to ensure a high level of safety is in force.
3. Judges must acquaint themselves with all aspects of the VH Showing rule book and keep their copy for reference during the show.
4. **Judges must not request/allow gallop in the class.**
5. Marks sheets must be completed for each class judged. Sheets must not be altered and any additions should be correctly checked. Do not leave this to your steward.
6. VH Showing reserve the right to remove from the panel any judge found to be guilty of misconduct.
7. Judges are asked to not judge an animal that is owned or has been previously owned by them.
8. Judges are asked to exercise discretion and not to judge more than two shows in the same area in the current year.
9. Judges can only judge one Regional Final in the current year and should not be within their county of residence.
10. If invited to judge the Grand Final at Olympia, they must not judge at any other VH Showing classes within that year.
11. Judges should ensure the three highest placed VH Showing members each receive a qualification card (which can be passed down the line) and will only be given on production of membership/registration show card/covering letter in their name.
12. In VH Showing open age classes qualification cards/vouchers are to be given out to members on registered mounts in each age group regardless of their placing.
13. Judges are asked to make sure that the Members and Non Members Qualification cards are given out correctly.
14. In all VH Showing classes, Dodson & Horrell prize vouchers are ONLY given to VHS members with VH Showing registered horses/ponies. Other show rosettes are to be given out to the highest placed animals.
15. Late entries are not allowed in the ring once the order to trot has been given.
16. No competitor will be judged if they have not completed the initial go around.
17. Shoeing: Therapeutic shoes and support pads are allowed within the VH Showing classes.
18. Any fall of horse and/or rider will result in disqualification. Riders will not be allowed to re-mount in the ring.
19. Marking system:
Out of 50 - Way of going, Manners .Movement
Out of 50 - Presentation, Condition, Type, Suppleness for age
20. Within the marking system, only walk, trot and canter will be marked during the classes. All other paces, (counter-canter, rein-back, flying changes) will not be marked.
21. **Judges are asked to refrain from touching the veteran horses/ponies in the class.**
